Global Care has always had a heart for marginalised girls. The joy of a 40-year ministry includes the joy of seeing so many healthy young women stand strong today, equipped to come through a difficult childhood thanks to the ministry of Global Care's international partners and our donors.

But our work for girls is far from over. Covid has undone decades of progress for girls, and that's why girls are at the heart of our anniversary year. When girls flourish, the whole community thrives.

***Amy joined Kolkata Emmanuel School as a sponsored child amid "a lot of difficulties and misery", say our partners, Emmanuel Ministries.**

When her chaotic family finally disintegrated, Amy lived with her grandmother. But Amy's gran couldn't afford to keep her, so Amy moved into the school's residential shelter.



Through all the trauma of change, separation, loss and abandonment, school was the stable factor in Amy's life.

Today Amy is doing an MA in Psychology in Mumbai. She's a fantastic role model for other girls struggling with poverty, caste discrimination and family breakdown.

Our partners say: *"The school looks up to Amy as a real example of a strong and independent woman working hard to change her future amidst all the hardship of life."*

14-year-old *Clemira has known little but chaos and fear since civil war began in Syria 12 years ago.

Her childhood is littered with traumatic events including bombardment, displacement, an absentee father, being robbed at home, witnessing the murder of a relative, experiencing the pandemic lockdowns in near total poverty and domestic violence. She has a history of attempted suicide.

"Clemira needed someone to hear her, understand her, hug her and care about her but they didn't do that," say our partners in Damascus. *"All attention was only to her brothers."*



At the Hope Centre, Clemira gets some of the attention she so badly needs.

She is taught with kindness and shown love. She learns that hope is possible.

Pray for girls like Amy, Clemira and Muthoni worldwide.

***Muthoni's mum died in 2019, leaving Muthoni and her sister in the care of their blind grandmother. Now Muthoni's aunt has taken them all in, but she has six children of her own to look after.**



They all live in a 10ft²

shack in Kibera, Kenya. Life is hard in this sprawling slum. But Muthoni is a pupil at Spurgeons Academy, where she is sponsored through Global Care. It's an enormous help.

Sponsorship gives Muthoni two healthy meals a day at school, a quality primary education, welfare support in the community - like food parcels throughout the Covid lockdowns - and access to medical care.

Despite poverty, bereavement and daily hardship, sponsorship gives Muthoni hope for a better future.


40TH ANNIVERSARY PRAYER DAY PRAY FOR OUR FUTURE

Forty years ago, no-one could have imagined or predicted our journey to 2023! Pray with us for God's guidance and provision as we look ahead.


If we look around us, we see reasons for concern:


Yet, if we look up, to our good God, we see reasons for hope.




Pray we would keep trusting
