

## God is always with us

This activity offers pupils the opportunity to reflect on God being with us always and everywhere. They will have the opportunity to take a symbol of this presence with them.

### Equipment:

- Safety pins of various sizes
- Small pieces of ribbon
- Small beads



### Instructions:

Note this prayer activity involves small safety pins so is not suitable for young children. Close supervision is necessary to ensure that pupils do not harm each other or themselves with the safety pin.

During a war many people had been separated from their friends and family. Some people's homes had been destroyed. Some people had to leave their home, their village or town, even their country to find somewhere safe to live. God was with them where ever they were.

Think about times you face during the day that can be difficult and when you'd really like to know God is with us, or even times when you are on our own and feel lonely. God is always there, but sometimes it's hard to remember that when we can't see him!

Take a safety pin and pin it somewhere on your clothes as a reminder that God is always with you and keeps you safe.

You might prefer to put it somewhere where no-one can see or you might have it on show as a potential talking point!

You might even want to personalise the safety pin with a couple of beads or a small strip of ribbon!
